

NON-MAJORS WHO WISH TO TAKE AN ART CLASS

The following classes are available to non-art majors. There are no prerequisites for these classes:

- ART-1300C Drawing Foundations (studio class)
- ART-1201C 2D Foundations (studio class)
- ART-1203 3D Foundations (studio class)
- ART-1602C Digital Imaging Foundations
- ART-2003C Contemporary Art Scholarship in Practice (This is a lecture class and students can register on their own. Note: this is an online class and a distance learning fee is assessed for this class.)

Conditions to allow enrollment in an ART class:

1. Students must wait until the last day of drop/add for the term to enroll.
2. The class must have at least one seat available.
3. Students must meet all pre-requisites for the class. Instructor permission is given on extremely rare cases when a student is able to demonstrate prior knowledge (through portfolio review or previous coursework) necessary for successful completion of the course.
