Candidates should be studying graphic arts or a similar field. The intern will gain experience in providing support to Florida Sheriffs Association's Director of Publications and Graphic Designer by designing graphics for use in media and multi-media products such as publications, CD-ROMs, advertising and signage. In addition, the intern will assist with the following tasks:

- Developing concepts, graphics and layouts for product illustrations, company logos, and website content
- Preparing rough drafts of material based on a creative brief
- Reviewing final layouts and suggesting improvements if required
- Working with external printers on a regular basis to ensure deadlines are met and material is printed to the highest quality.

- Major in graphic art/design or related field
- Working knowledge of InDesign, Illustrator and Photoshop
- G.P.A. – 2.5 minimum
- Meets the institution's standards and requirements for participation in an internship program.
- Ability to work a minimum of 15 hours per week for 10-12 weeks.
