Contract Employee Job Description ART INSTRUCTOR Hourly Pay \$20

This position reports directly to the Education Coordinator. Duties:

- 1. Drawing and Painting Class (Thursdays, 3-5pm)
 - Design and teach discipline-based drawing and painting class, with students ranging from high school to adult, and beginner to advanced levels.
 - b. Introduce students to new studio skills such as sketching, sketchbook practices, art basics, warm-up activities, and planning.
 - c. Provide individualized instruction in the application of skills to the completion of larger projects.
 - d. Expose students over time to a variety of drawing, watercolor, and acrylic painting mediums.

Required Qualifications:

- Knowledge of art (college students at the junior, senior, or graduate level studying art history, studio art, and/or art education only)
- Studio art teaching experience with children or adults
- Ability to teach varying skill levels and ages
- Flexibility to teach different students every week, with varying skill levels, and varying art goals

Desirable Qualifications:

- Knowledge of current art education theories and practices
- Knowledge of art history
- Experience working in a museum environment
- Digital photography and Photoshop skills, to assist students with documenting their artwork
