

NWFSC TO FSU

Students wishing to transfer from **Northwest Florida State College to Florida State University** can take the following courses at Northwest in preparation for the BA or BFA in Studio Art Programs. Students can enter the Studio Art Program at FSU in Fall, Spring and Summer terms and there is no portfolio required.

ELECTIVE CREDIT:

Students can take up to 24 hours of elective credit toward the AA degree.

STUDIO ART ELECTIVES RECOMMENDED: 6 HOURS*

ART 2330C Figure Drawing I (3)

* FSU limits transfer of non-foundation studio art credits to six (6) that count toward the major. Additional studio credits count as general electives toward the 120 hours needed for the BA/BFA degree.

OTHER RECOMMENDED ELECTIVE COURSES:

Speech: Students can take SPC 1006 - Essentials of Speech or SPC 1608 - Public Speaking to satisfy FSU's Oral Communication Competency requirement.

Foreign Language: Proficiency in a foreign language at the Intermediate/2200 level is required for the BA in Studio Art Degree. It is recommended that students complete the entire sequence of foreign language courses (course numbers ending in 1120, 1121 and 2200, offered in Spanish, while attending Northwest Florida State College. Alternatively, students can complete the first two courses of this sequence (course numbers ending in 1120, 1121, offered in French and Chinese) at Northwest and then complete the 2200 level course at FSU.
